Read & Reflect

1. Read John 15:1-8, 16. Can you identify 3 purposes or reasons for prayer in this passage?

2. Reflect on the statement: Jesus' one specific purpose was to glorify the Father. Do you agree with this or not? Explain.
3. If you are a Christian, you will bear fruit. How does prayer affect the abundance and quality of fruit?
4. What does it mean to abide in God? What are ways to effectively abide in Him?
5. Prayer is not a passive activity. It encourages us to seek out ways to be the answer to others' prayers. What are some ways you can do this?
6. Prayer can be a great form of evangelism. Have you ever used prayer to reach out to others? What were the results?
7. How would your relationship with Christ be affected if God never granted your most pressing request the way you would like?

- Pray for opportunities to pray for others.
- Think of at least one dream/hope you are willing to boldly and audaciously ask of God. Pray with faith for that dream/hope.
