Let Justice Roll Down Justice & Race: Il Corinthians 5:14-21 Discussion Points November 5, 2017

Read & Reflect

- 1. Read 2 Corinthians 5:11-21. You may have to read it twice to catch the flow of Paul's thought. Perhaps read the passage in another version to catch nuances or emphases. What catches your attention?
- 2. Read the following two passages: Galatians 3:26-29 and Ephesians 2:11-22. What parallels do these passages have with 2 Corinthians 5:11-21?

Explore

- 3. Where have you tended to place your identity? What has it meant to you to place your identity in Christ? How has it changed your view of others?
- 4. What are some of the stereotypes with which you identify people in your community? How do those generalizations place barriers in a personal relationship with them? Speak of a time when those barriers came down? How did that change your perspective or attitude?
- 5. What radical impact can the gospel of Jesus Christ have upon social barriers in our church? In our community? What role might you have to play in that change?
- 6. How familiar are you with people from our "First Nations?" Are you aware of the "Indian Residential School" history? What do you think of Canada's "Truth and Reconciliation" process? Is it necessary? Is it effective? You can learn more at http://nctr.ca/about-new.php.
- 7. What general attitudes and thoughts do you have about race relations when it comes to immigration and refugee settlement? You can learn more about that at http://www.cpj.ca/refugees.
