



Serve to Lead - Matthew 20:17-34

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1. Pray for eyes to see the extent of God's kingdom in your neighbourhood (or place of work, or school, or vacation spot, etc) and for the vision to see how you could be a servant for Christ.

Action

- 1. Where in your neighbourhood do you see opportunity to serve so that the light of God's rule (his love, his compassion, his mercy, his justice, his authority, his peace, his joy) could shine?
- 2. What action do you have to take to prepare yourself to be a servant?
 - Recognize how I have been served by others.

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- 1. Which statement(s) could apply to you? (what have people heard you say?)
 - a. I help people if they come to me, but otherwise I mind my own business.
 - b. I go out of my way to help people because I love to be needed.
 - c. I look hard for ways to help people, otherwise I get self-absorbed.
 - d. I don't notice that I help people, but others say I'm always there for them.
 - e. I rarely help people because I'm too busy.
- 2. You help someone out and they respond, "Oh, you don't have to do that," or "Why would you do that for me?" What could you say to explain the character of God's kingdom and why you serve as a follower of Jesus. Write it out.
