Abraham – When You're Sure God is Wrong

Discussion Points

April 22, 2018

Read & Reflect:

1. Read Genesis 22.
2. Do you think this story is more about what kind of God we are dealing with or about how Abraham lived by faith (and how we ought to do the same)?
3. How does this story point to Christ?

Explore:

4. Have you ever experienced God in an uncomfortable way, or regarded him as an “impossible” God? What did you learn about God in that time?
5. When you sense God’s call to serve the biggest hurdle is:
 - surrendering my agenda
 - bending my attitude for worship
 - Trusting God will provide whatever I lack
6. Explain about a time when serving really felt like worshipping God.
7. What exactly was God testing when it says, “God tested Abraham” (22:1, see vs.12)? If God were to test you, what would he test you for?

Pray:

- Place yourself in one of three situations: facing an uncomfortable God, caught in an uncomfortable response, or in the middle of an uncomfortable test.
- Commit one another to prayer in those specific situations.
- Sing a song like the old hymn: *Trust and Obey*, or *I Surrender All*
