Read & Reflect

1. Read Luke 24: 13-35; then read it again out loud and slowly in another translation. (Especially if the passage is familiar to you). What stands out to you about the story?

Explore

2. What was the most memorable (best) time you ever spend in communion around a dinner table?
3. What was the most memorable (worst) time you ever spend in communion around a dinner table?
4. What are some of the things that get in the way or cause us to lose focus on prioritizing communion as a family?
5. What would it look like to re-prioritize communion with your family? What sacrifices and changes need to be made?
6. Who could you and your family invite to share the gift of communion with? Who could you share the vision of God's kingdom with?
7. As a family sing **Praise Ye the Lord** together "Beugelink style". If it's safe allow family members to stand on their chairs when they sing their part of the song. (The Hallelu' stand in chairs while the Praise Yea's sit then vice versa when they change.)

Pray:

- Praise God for the ordinary rituals that reveal his work in our life. Then praise him for the extraordinary ways he works in our life.
- Ask God for forgiveness if priorities have overtaken time and space for communion.
- Ask the Holy Spirit for wisdom and discernment on how to make space and time for communion.
- Close by saying the Lord's Prayer together.

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
