1. Read Luke 14:25-35. What do you think your response would have been to Jesus only knowing what those present knew? How would you have received that word?
2. Read Luke 14:28-30. What does this passage have to do with being a disciple of Christ?

3. In Matthew 6:24, Jesus says that no one can serve two masters, referring to money specifically. Does the same principal apply to every area of our lives? Can you truly love God and love something else?
4. What areas of your life do you tend to pour out the most of your devotion into?

6. What is the difference between a sin conscious life and a righteous conscious life? How have you seen both at work in your life?
