Read/Reflect

1. Read Hebrews 12:10-12. What kind of harvest is being talked about here?
2. Read John 4:34-38. What kind of harvest is being talked about here?
3. According to the Hebrews passage what does hardship demonstrate about a person's relationship to God?
4. Read John 4:27-42. What impact does Jesus have on the woman at the well? (see vs.28a), and how does that effect the woman's actions after that?

Explore

5. What does it mean to produce a harvest of righteousness? What are the kinds of things that you need to sow to harvest righteousness?
 - fix my eyes on Jesus (Hebrews 12:2)
 - submit to God's discipline (Hebrews 12:7)
 - Sow peace, holiness and love (Hebrews 12:14,15)
6. Whatever difficult thing you are going through at this time in your life, how might God be using it to "produce a harvest of righteousness?"
7. How does what Jesus says about a harvest apply to the disciples? How does it apply to you?
8. What do you learn about being a witness to the Good News from the woman, and from Jesus' analogy of a harvest?
9. At this time in your life what might be a priority – to be pouring in (sowing for a harvest of righteousness) or pouring out (a worker for the harvest that is in front of you)?

Pray

- Invite the Spirit to equip you for whatever emphasis you chose in question 9.
- Pray for others you know to see the harvest of righteousness or in being workers of the harvest of hearts.
