3. When have you lost perspective, thinking that the purpose of your life is all about you? What helped to change that perspective?
4. What are some memories that have shaped your calling in life?
5. How does God's ultimate act of salvation shape your place in this world (e.g. God saved you *from* sin, and he saved you *for* what?)?
6. What are some ways that you are involved in demonstrating the way of God's kingdom in this world?
7. In what new way will you embrace the mission of God for a radical, gospel impact this church season?
