Hurricane Eta and Iota Response

Honduras and much of Central America was ravaged by 2 Category 4 hurricanes within 2 weeks, leaving a trail of destruction and heartbreak throughout the region.



Men, women and children were left homeless while churches, schools and any other stable structure became temporary shelters.

The back-to-back hurricanes left the ground heavily saturated and the land quickly succumbed to mudslides and flash flooding. And, as rivers and creeks overflowed, roadways became fast-moving waterways that carried away the debris of fallen trees and destroyed homes.

Reports confirmed that communities where World Renew works, including Laure, were affected and evacuations were taking place.



The back-to-back hurricanes have already caused so much devastation, but the danger isn't over. Continuing torrential rains threaten to cause more flooding and mudslides. Many of those affected by the flooding are subsistence farmers whose crops, their only source of income, have been washed away. Shelters are overcrowded and the looming threat of COVID-19 continues. An estimated 2 million people in Honduras do not have basic access to food, clean drinking water, shelter, sanitation and hygiene services.



The people of Latin America need our support and our prayers to weather the immediate hardships and the difficult rebuilding process ahead. We pray that God will bless the people affected by the hurricanes with courage as they move forward. We pray the rain and flooding will soon end and the people in shelters will stay healthy and COVID-free.

World Renew is continuing to respond by providing food, shelter items and hygiene kits for families in Honduras. World Renew is looking to raise \$100,000 USD. The first \$25,000 USD will be matched 1:1 through their International Disaster Response Fund.

Donating to Fernando's Ministry in Colombia

At this time, Fernando does not have a connection to a Canadian Charity, and as such, CRA regulations prohibit us from sending finances to his ministry. New Life Missions Team is working with Fernando and another Christian Ministry to connect Fernando with that organization so that we can once again support his ministry financially. This is a lengthy and complicated process, but we trust that God is directing this path and that He will make the way smooth.

Fernando remains a New Life missionary and his ministry continues—we support his ministry in prayer and encouragement while we wait for the legalities to be completed and we can support him financially once again.

In the mean time, Fernando continues to work with children and youth in Bogota and surrounding areas. He has requested help with giving children Christmas presents (see picture next page). We encourage you to help him, but you must follow the instructions provided to do so. You cannot give through New Life and New Life cannot issue receipts for the support you give Fernando at this time. If you wish to support the Christmas gifts fund, please do so directly with Fernando via the 2 options noted on page 14.



Our last activity of this year will be our Christmas closing where we will provide gifts and food to all 180 children of our social program.

This activity will be next Saturday, December 12 The cost of the gift per child is US \$ 33.00
