### Read/Reflect

1. Read Ephesians 4:1-7. What kind of picture develops in your mind as you reflect on this passage?
2. Read Philippians 3:20-21. What kind of picture develops in your mind from these verses? Is it compatible with the picture from Ephesians 4, or with the life you live right now?

### Explore

3. What is your definition of a good citizen in any circumstance? Have you ever lived in a place (or even a different time) where good citizenship had different values than your own?
4. How does being online make you think about good citizenship?
5. In what ways do your digital devices distract you from the goal of living to the glory of God or from living in (comm)unity?

  - Bearing with one another in love (because our love of neighbour (even enemies) is rooted in the love of God, and because love casts out fear).
