Read/Reflect

- 1. Read Matthew 13:44-45. And then read the rest of the chapter. What are some of the lessons that Jesus is trying to help us understand about the nature of the Kingdom?
- 2. How does someone enter the Kingdom of God? Hint: Read Mark 14:36.
- 3. How is entering the Kingdom of God both a choice and a lived outcome?
- 4. List some of the things in your life that your invested in. Beyond your financial portfolio, what are some of the causes/institutions that you're hoping will pay off in your life?

Go Deeper

- 1. In the sermon, Pastor Bruce talked about how the good news of the gospel is not just about going to heaven when we die, but about being agents of God's Kingdom on earth; in other words, "making up there come down here." How might this way of thinking about the gospel change the way you live? For example, how might you look after God's creation differently?
- 2. Reflect on how you are using your time, talents and treasures to invest in God's coming Kingdom. What are some of the practical things you are doing? How can you improve?
