Discussion Points

Read/Reflect

1. What do you think about when you hear the word SIN?
2. Why, do you think, God hates sin?
3. Why is understanding that you are a sinner the first (and most important) step in leaving your sin baggage behind? (Hint: think AA)
4. Read the suggested passage. Do you identify with Peter? In what way?
5. Read Psalm 51 out loud. Reflect.

Go Deeper

1. Given Luke 5:1-11, why do you think the catch of great fish so important in this context. What is Jesus trying to say to Peter?
2. Have you ever said, in your mind or in your heart, “Get away from Jesus, I’m a sinful man/woman/person?”
3. Why is confession so important? Why does it need to be daily discipline?
4. To whom do you need to make amends this week?
5. In the message, Pastor Bruce talked about how Jesus formed a “new intention” in Peter; specifically, to become “a fisher of men”. What new intention is God forming in you? Think about your daily life.

Pray

- ✝ Read Psalm 51. Confess.
- ✝ Pray Psalm 51 again, and, as you do, ask God to form a new intention in you. Concentrate on the words, “create in me a clean heart”.
- ✝ Make Psalm 51 your go to Psalm for this week.



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
