		Not placing or being an obstacle for others (vs.13)
		Seek first the kingdom, not your own ideas (vs.17,18)
		Guarding your opinions between you and God (vs.22)

- 5. What are the "disputable matters" (vs.1) that Paul discusses in Romans 14? What are some disputable matters today?
- 6. Choosing one of the above issues you've listed, how does it effect your relationships, how does it effect unity in the body of Christ? How might you apply some of the instructions from Rom.14 to bring healing, even if only to yourself?
