Read/Reflect

Explore

- 3. Does this Psalm change your thinking in any way concerning your views on what constitute true worship?
- 4. While we are often reminded to be humble, yet we have also been challenged to excel and strive for higher goals (Philippians 3: 12 14). How do we balance between humility and taking pride in some earthly achievements?
- 5. Is pride always a bad thing? What and How can we differentiate them?
- 6. In what ways does your life reflect your hope in the Lord now and into the future? Give a few specific recent examples.

- That we will strive to maintain a close and intimate relationship with God that will not stifle our worship.
