3. Does this Psalm change your thinking in any way concerning your views on what constitute true worship?
4. While we are often reminded to be humble, yet we have also been challenged to excel and strive for higher goals (Philippians 3: 12 – 14). How do we balance between humility and taking pride in some earthly achievements?
5. Is pride always a bad thing? What and How can we differentiate them?
6. In what ways does your life reflect your hope in the Lord now and into the future? Give a few specific recent examples.
