Discussion Points
February 6, 2022

#### Read/Reflect

- 1. Read Psalm 73:1-28
- 2. Reflect on Asaph's 3 main focus shifts throughout this Psalm. vs. 3-12; vs. 13-16; vs. 17-28

#### **Explore**

- 3. In what ways can you personally identify with the battle that Asaph faced when looking at the "wicked" of the world?
- 4. In what ways can you identify with his inward perspective after having observed the prosperity of the wicked?
- 5. Discuss some of the dangers of focusing on the "ways of the world" and the prosperity of the wicked. What can that produce in our own lives?
- 6. What is the key moment that causes Asaph to shift his focus off the world and off himself and back onto God? Discuss why it was such a drastic change for him.
- 7. What does entering into the sanctuary of God look like for you? Can you share a time where you had a focus shift as a result of entering Gods' sanctuary?
- 8. Asaph's role, as a Levite, was to prepare God's sanctuary for His people. 1 Peter 2:9 says that those of us in Christ are now are the Royal Priesthood. What does it mean to your personally to be a priest and to help usher others into God's presence?

- Read and Pray Galatians 6:9 over each other, that we might not grow weary of doing good in these difficult times.
- Read and Pray 1 Peter 2:9 over each other as a reminder of our purpose and ministry on earth.
- Read and Pray Phil 3:14 over each other as a reminder of the eternal goal.
