How to Walk with Jesus Himself

Read/Reflect

1. Read Luke 24:13-35.
2. What part of the story do you connect with the most?
3. Why does Jesus begin with “Moses and the prophets” to help the two disciples comprehend the Messiah? What Old Testament scriptures might Jesus have highlighted?

Explore

4. Has there been a time in your life when things didn't turn out as you expected? What kinds of emotions and attitudes do you wrestle with when your hopes and dreams collapse?
5. What kinds of things can lead you into a crisis of faith?
 - ☐ Personal financial issues
 - ☐ Global issues or world events
 - ☐ Major decisions in your life
 - ☐ Relationship conflicts
 - ☐ Disappointment with what you love the most
6. Why does Luke report on Jesus meeting up with only two people when he could have (should have?) met up with his disciples, or his friends in Bethany, or even the religious leaders in Jerusalem, to show off his victory?
7. Why do you think Jesus did not immediately reveal who he was to the two disciples; he walks with them for possibly 10 kilometres, he eats supper with them, and only (finally) then they recognize him. What does that say about what the risen Christ means for your faith?
8. When have you been deeply encouraged in your faith or seen Jesus show up in your life? What helped you to become aware of God's presence?

- That as Jesus walks with you in your life's journey, you may realize his presence, rejoicing that he has revealed himself to you in all kinds of ways.
