Read/Reflect

- 1. Read Luke 11:1-13. Jesus taught his disciples by giving a prayer (vs.2-4), telling a parable (vs.5-8), and two pieces of advice on how to approach prayer (a. vs.9,10; b. vs.11-13). Summarize each of these elements.
- 2. What is your reaction to each of these elements? Is there a general statement about prayer that Jesus is trying to make?

Explore

- 3. What do you think the disciples were after in seeking to learn about prayer? What are you after if you were to ask the same of Jesus: "Teach me to pray"? Do you think Jesus' objective was different than the disciples' objective?
- 4. What are some of the attitudes (positive or negative) you have towards prayer? How did you learn those attitudes or assumptions about prayer?
- 5. When is the last time you prayed the "Lord's Prayer?" What does it mean to you?
