Read/Reflect

1. Read Matthew 26: 47 – 56. What two things stand out in this passage to you and why?
2. Do you think the betrayal by Judas could have been averted? Is God unfair to Judas that he was to be the one who betrayed Jesus?
3. Why did Judas address Jesus as “Rabbi” and not “Lord”?

Explore

1. How willing are you in making sacrifices for our Lord Jesus? Please share one or two personal experiences.
2. Have you ever been betrayed by a friend or relative before? How did you handle it?
3. Have you ever used “forceful” ways to evangelize the Gospel to someone who is either inferior in position to you or much younger in age? How did it turn out?
4. All the disciples left him (Jesus) and fled. What would you have done if you were at the scene of Jesus’ arrest?
