## **Explore**

- 2. Have you ever been betrayed by a friend or relative before? How did you handle it?
- 3. Have you ever used "forceful" ways to evangelize the Gospel to someone who is either inferior in position to you or much younger in age? How did it turn out?
- 4. All the disciples left him (Jesus) and fled. What would you have done if you were at the scene of Jesus' arrest?
