 - □ All the above mixed through each other.
- 4. Where do you sense dissonance in your life (clash or disharmony)? Are you able to "make music" out of it, or how otherwise do you resolve it?
- 5. Is there a longing for heaven in your life? How do you balance that with pressing on in life?
