- 1. When you hear the phrase "Heart of _____," what do you think it means?
- 2. In your own words, what would you say is the "heart" of the Church?
- 3. Would you say gathering together as God's people is important and necessary? Why or why not?
- 4. What would you say is the role of the Holy Spirit in the Church?
- 5. How would you define "worship"? Do you see this as the "heart" of the Church? Why or why not?
- 6. How is Mission connected to worship? How are they connected in your own life? If they are not connected, why not?
