

Identity Check A Person of Faith

Read/Reflect

- 1. Read Colossians 3:1-4; then follow the line of argument starting at Colossians 2:6-23. What are some of the things that pull us away from keeping our identity in Christ in these verses of chapter 2?
- 2. What does it mean to be raised with Christ (3:1)?

Explore

- 1. To what things are you tied or committed that shape your identity?
- 2. Wonder about the phrase, "For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God" (3:3). What can you say about your own experience of having "died", and how your life is "hidden with Christ"?
- 3. In what ways do you live out your identity as a person of faith, and how does that compare to Paul's recommendations starting at 3:12
- 4. Do you identify yourself with any of the labels mentioned in verse 12: chosen, holy, dearly loved? What part of that identity do you most value? What part do you need to live into more?

Pray

- Confess to God some of the ways that your identity in Christ is compromised (e.g. idols in your life).
- Pray to be filled with the Holy Spirit in such a way as to more fully live out your identity in Christ (which is the only way we can live into that identity).
