Read/Reflect

1. What are your Thanksgiving traditions? Is there something you or your family do that is unique? Share.
2. The diagnosis of leprosy in ancient times was a death sentence. It also meant you would be ostracized from everyone you knew and loved. Are there modern forms of leprosy?
3. Read Luke 17:11-19 out loud. Remembering that Luke was a doctor, how might have this shaped his recounting of this story?

Explore

1. What does it mean to have a grateful heart? How do you express this? Share 5 things that you are extremely grateful for.
2. "Only one of the ten came back to thank Jesus". Only 10 percent. Is this characteristic of our culture?
3. How do you or someone you know need to be healed by Jesus today?
