Read/Reflect

- 1. Read Acts 9:32-43. Given the stature of the apostle Paul in the rest of the book of Acts, why does Luke not continue with the story of Saul/Paul (which is what he started in Acts 9:1-31)?
- 2. Compare Luke 5:20-26 with Acts 9:32-35 and compare Luke 8:49-56 with Acts 9:36-43. Notice the similarities and the differences. What might Luke be doing in featuring these parallel stories?

Explore

- 3. What is the purpose of healings and miracles in the life of the church? For instance, why did Stephen die (Acts 8:1) but Tabitha lived (Acts 9:41)?
- 4. In what ways do you, or can you, imitate how Jesus moved around in the world? As a disciple, do you see yourself as one who practices the life of Jesus in your daily actions and routines?
- 5. What is your expectation for how the church should be present in the world?
 - Lt should demonstrate the coming of God's kingdom.
 - □ It should be impressive enough to impress unbelievers.
 - □ It should influence the surrounding society, culture, and government.
 - Let has a spiritual impact on individuals in society.
- 6. What is your expectation of how you should live your life as a Christian in the world?
 - □ I need to help build the kingdom of God.
 - □ I show off signs of God at work.
 - □ I can support movements that change the world for Christ.
 - □ I can grow in my personal relationship with Jesus.
