## ACTS – A Church Sent God is Doing a New Thing - Acts 11:1-18

## **Read/Reflect**

- 1. How did Peter's vision change his perspective on the Gentiles? How does the rest of the story in vv.11-17 affirm God's plan for the inclusion of Gentiles?
- 2. How did Peter respond to the vision? What can we learn from Peter's response?
- 3. Why did the circumcised believers criticize Peter for associating with Gentiles? How does Peter respond to their criticism?

## Explore

- 1. What might be some biases or assumptions that sometimes get in the way of seeing God's plan in your life?
- 2. How did God reveal His plan for including the Gentiles through Cornelius and Peter? How can we be open to God's plans that might challenge our existing beliefs or practices?
- 3. What is the significance of the Holy Spirit coming upon the Gentiles in the same way as the Jewish believers?
- 4. How does Peter's statement in verse 17 challenge and teach us to trust God's plans? Are there areas in your life where God might be leading you to take a step of obedience despite not fully understanding His will?
- 5. Have you ever shared with others what God has done in your life? How did your sharing help others understand God's character and/or plans?

## Pray

- What is the one take-away from this study that you could begin to live out this week?
- Ask the Holy Spirit to help you
  - o to stay attentive to God's Spirit working in your life, in your life group, and at New Life.
  - to reveal any biases or false assumptions that might hinder you from seeing God's work in your life, in your life group, and at New Life.
  - to respond in obedience when God brings changes even when it's unexpected and uncomfortable.
