Read/Reflect

1. What stood out to you most from Genesis 15 or this week's sermon?
2. Where did you see yourself in Abram's questions, doubts, or waiting?

Explore

3. Why do you think God begins with “Do not be afraid” when speaking to Abram? What current situation in your life feels like stepping toward the unknown?
4. Abram challenges God directly about the lack of children and land. What does this show about how God invites us to pray? Where do you find it difficult to express your doubts honestly to God?
5. In the covenant ceremony, only God walks between the pieces. What does this tell us about His commitment? How does this affect your confidence in God's promises?
6. The sermon described faith as surrender, not striving. Where do you sense God asking you to surrender your need for control? What does letting God “carry you” look like in your week ahead?
7. In what ways does knowing Jesus fulfills our side of the covenant bring rest to your soul?

Pray

- Acknowledge the doubt and weakness of your faith to God, and pray for courage to trust God in areas of uncertainty.
- Praise God for his amazing grace, and thank Him for carrying the full weight of His promises, so that nothing will separate you from the love of God.
