Body of Christ - Anatomy of Redemption

The Feet of Jesus – Luke 19:28-40, Isaiah 52:7

Read/Reflect

1. According to Isaiah 52:7, what makes a person's feet beautiful? What do you think Jesus' feet looked like? Do you think they were beautiful?
2. Read Luke 7:36-39. Can you imagine wiping someone's feet with your hair? Do you think that she thought Jesus' feet were beautiful? Why?
3. Why do you think it is recorded how Jesus acquired the donkey that he used on Palm Sunday? Why did he choose a donkey? What does that say about who Jesus is and the kind of kingdom he came to bring into being?
4. What were the people expecting of Jesus as he rode into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday? How was that different from the kingdom Jesus came to bring?
5. What is the significance of Jesus' feet walking the earth?

Explore

6. What do we expect from Jesus? Comfort? Privilege? Control? What does humility look like? Is it difficult to accept grace?
7. Jesus said to the crowds following him that they had to take up their cross and follow him (Luke 14:27). What does it mean for you to surrender to the way of Jesus? What does cross bearing look like?
8. Jesus' feet were nailed to the cross for us, what does it mean for us to give ourselves for others?
9. What makes for beautiful feet today? What does it look like to have the feet of Jesus? Do you have beautiful feet?

- Pray for the grace to surrender our lives to Jesus and to follow Him.
