Read/Reflect

1. Read Galatians 6: 7-10. What words or phrase stands out to you in this passage? Why?
2. Paul says, "Let us not become weary in doing good." What does Paul mean by doing good (see verse 8b and 5:22-25)? What makes you weary in doing good?
3. What would the Galatian Christians be waiting for, or anxious about, that Paul would promise a harvest (vs. 9) in due time?

Explore

4. Reflecting on the past few months, what is a moment, an encounter, a conversation, or an act of service that helped you experience God's love?
5. What are some (maybe small) things from this ministry year at New Life that may have helped someone experience God's love?
6. Where have you seen God's kingdom being "shown off" through simple faithfulness rather than big or dramatic events?
7. What keeps you from becoming "weary in doing good," or when you are weary what restores your spirit?

- Give thanks for the ministry opportunities God has given you to bless, strengthen, or encourage others.
- Pray a blessing (over one another if in a group) for rest in the summer, hearing Jesus' invitation to learn from him, "for [he] is gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls."
